Application Information Guide

Qualification for Entry

The applicant must have finished an iron distance event during the 18 months prior to the date applications close, with a finishing time under 14.5 hours. The Application Review Committee will take into account other long distance and endurance events in individual disciplines, and a demonstrated ability to finish all three stages of Ultraman Australia. Applicants should provide as much as information as possible about their race history.

UM Australia is an independent event, and is not affiliated with any other Ultraman distance event, nor any event with a similarname.

Fees

Entry fee of AUD \$2,100 (includes all taxes and fees) will be charged after the athlete has received and accepted an Invitation to Race. After fees are processed, the Withdrawals & Refunds policy will apply.

Application and Invitation Process

The Application Review Committee will select 55 (Fifty-five) entries. Selected applicants will receive an Invitation to Race. Other qualified applicants may choose to be added to the Wait List, and may receive invitations as positions become available, at the discretion of the Application Review Committee.

The decisions of the Application Review Committee are final.

Application Timeline

May 1, 2019	Applications open
June 15, 2019	Applications Close at 5.00pm Eastern Standard Time*
June 15, 2019	Application Review Committee selection process begins
June 30. 2019	Invitations emailed and entry fee processed in full

Refund and Withdrawal Policy

If you withdraw from the event for any reason, the following refund policy will apply:

Until October 30, 2019 A \$200 processing fee will be deducted from your refund.

Until January 15, 2020 A 50% cancellation fee will be incurred.

After January 15, 2020 No refunds will be offered to athletes withdrawing from the event.

All refunds when processed are final. It is the athlete's responsibility to ensure that the intention to withdraw has been received by UM Australia.

Inclusions and Exclusion

The Entry fee covers the athlete and two land crew members (minimum requirement), and includes:

- 3 x Breakfast Tickets (1 Athlete and 2 Crew)
- 3 x Award Banquet Tickets (1 Athlete and 2 Crew)
- 3 x Massages (one at the end of each stage for the athlete)
- 2 x Crew T-Shirts
- Finisher or Participant Award
- Finisher Garment for Official Finishers
- Registration Gift Bag

Entry fee does NOT include:


- Any accommodation anywhere
- Transportation to and from Noosa
- Meals, other than those listed as part of the entry fee
- Nutritional needs
- Other race supplies
- Vehicle rentals
- Expenses associated with additional crew, swim escort and boat requirements.
